Introductory Survey course in Jewish Studies (choose one):

- JWST 2644: Introduction to Judaism
- JWST 2651: Judaism, Christianity and Islam
- JWST 2676: Holy War, Crusade and Jihad from Antiquity to Present
- JWST 2569: History and Jewish Diaspora
- An equivalent course in Jewish Studies, approved by the Director

Two Jewish Studies courses at the 2000-level or above, one course whose chronological parameters fall within the period 3000 BCE to 600 CE, and one course whose chronological parameters fall within the period 600 CE to the present.
